Online mid-term exams conducted

To meet challenges that emerged due to second spike of Covid-19 pandemic and lockdown situations in Pakistan, the Bakhtawar Cadet College for Grils, Nawabshah, conducted online mid-term examination of all classes from 14th to 19th December, 2020.

Academic activities suspended due to COVID-19

In view of the prevalent conditions with reference to contagious virus, the college suspended all on-campus academic activities from 18th November 2020 to 10th January 2021. The cadets and staff headed to their homes however, teachers reported back on 30th November 2020 to discuss further strategies to meet challenges that emerged due second spike of COVID-19 and to start online classes so that the situation does not stop process of learning. The college started online classes from 1st December 2020 to complete syllabus timely.

Admissions for new batch announced

College announced admissions for class VIII 2021-22 on 29th Nov 2020. The students who have passed their class VII with minimum 60% marks or studying in class VII and are between 12-14 years of age may apply.

For parents/ guardians' facilitation, the college has arranged distribution of prospectus to the almost all TCS centers of the country so that the prospectus may be purchased easily from their cities. Last date for submission of form shall be 16th Jan 2021 while the written test shall be held on 24th Jan 2021 at Shaheed Benazirabad (Nawabshah), Sukkur, Hyderabad and Lahore (subject to number of candidates).

- ♦ Updation of Science Labs

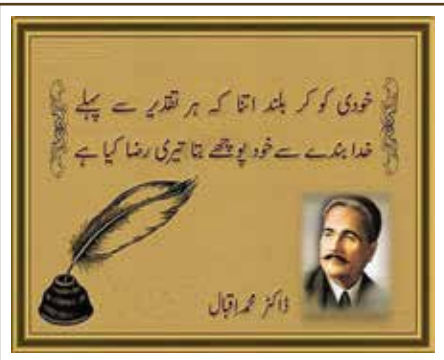

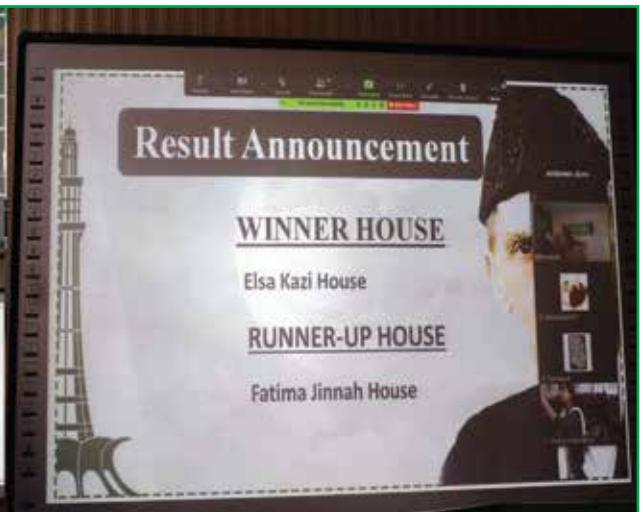
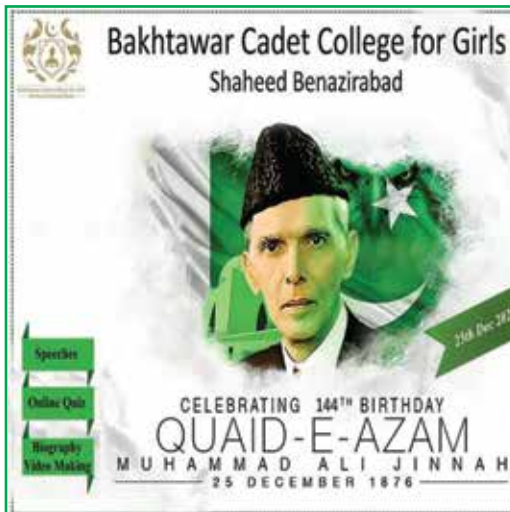
